Fast Facts on 'sub par' performance by local government

- Incumbent Gloria Martin voted to borrow \$8,460,000 to buy and renovate Picadome Golf Course and swimming pool. The Picadome swimming pool did not open this summer because local government could not afford to operate the facility.
- The annual debt payment for Picadome would provide a \$675 raise for every firefighter and police officer in Fayette County for 20 years.
- Lexington's Urban County Government votes to buy a sixth golf course instead of voting to fairly compensate its public safety employees.
- Ed Lane believes public safety and adequately paying our officers and firefighters is local government's number one priority.
